## Faculty Statistics

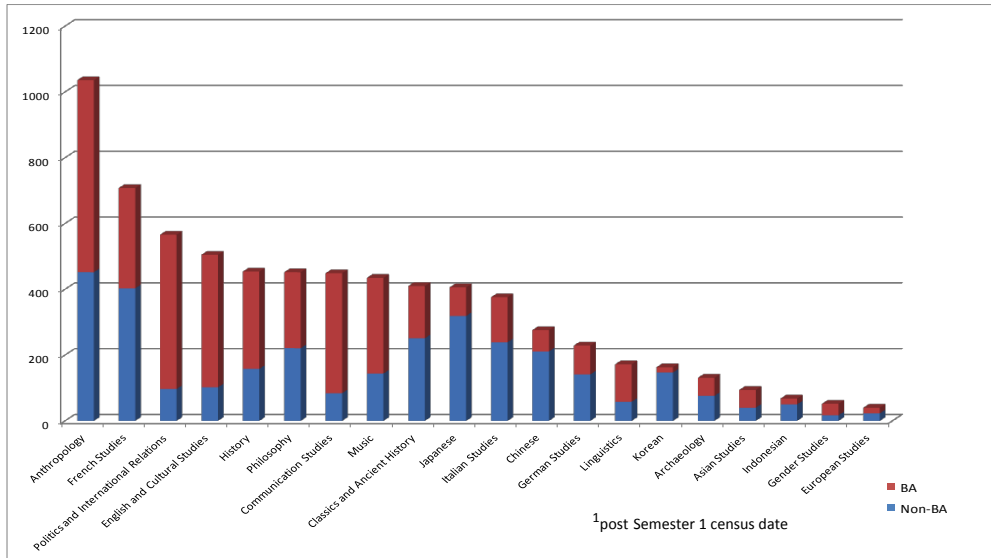
- 27% increase in Level 1 unit enrolments overall
- Actual gap will be wider - Semester 2 enrolments still ongoing
- Over 20% of level 1 enrolments are from 'other' courses
- Core subset: 7022 enrolments

## Faculty Statistics

- 46% of core subset are from students not enrolled in the BA (25% in 2011)
- 82% of non-BA unit enrolments are from the new BSci.

## Analysis

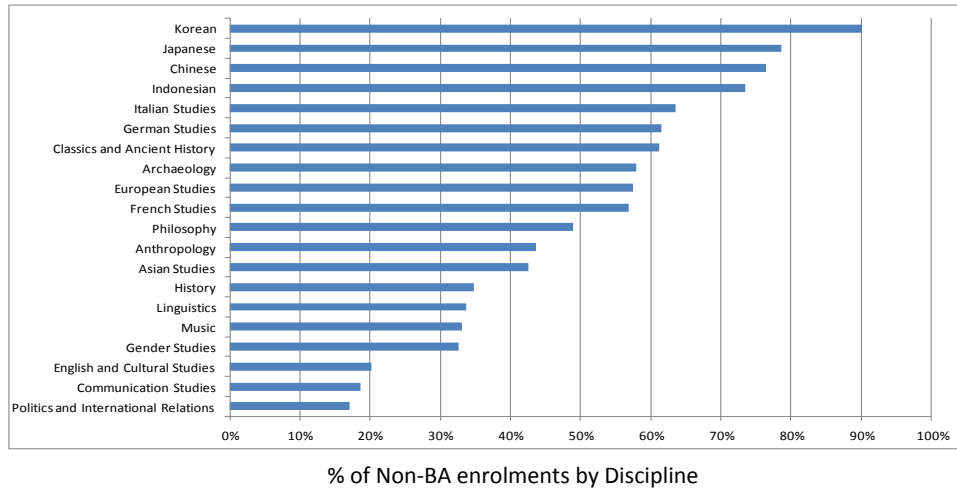
- 13/20 Disciplines substantially up
  - Korean, Italian Studies, German Studies approx 100-150%↑
- 4/20 Disciplines fairly constant over 2 semesters
  - Archaeology, Asian Studies, History, Politics
- 3/20 Disciplines have declined
  - ECS, European Studies, Linguistics
- Marked Semester 1 surges for some Disciplines
  - Asian Studies, History, Music and Philosophy

Distribution by Discipline: NC Enrolments<sup>1</sup>

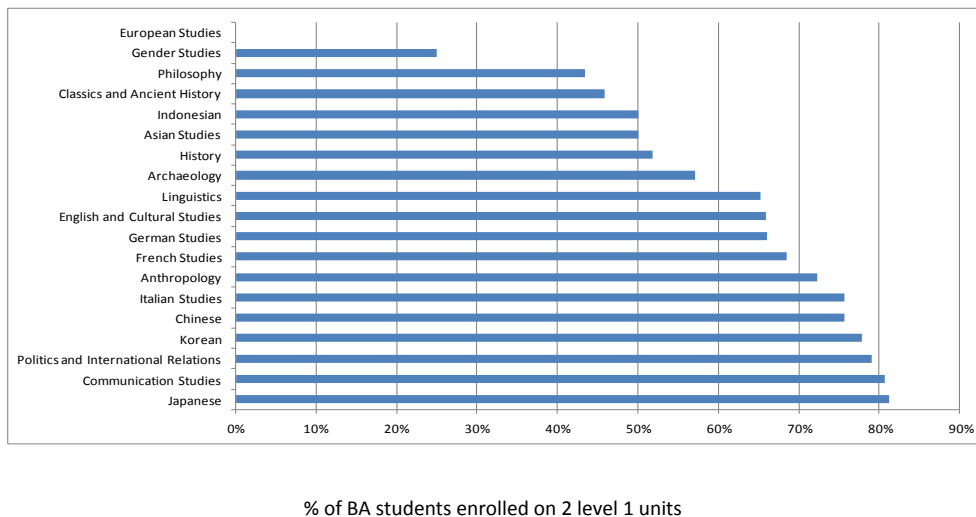

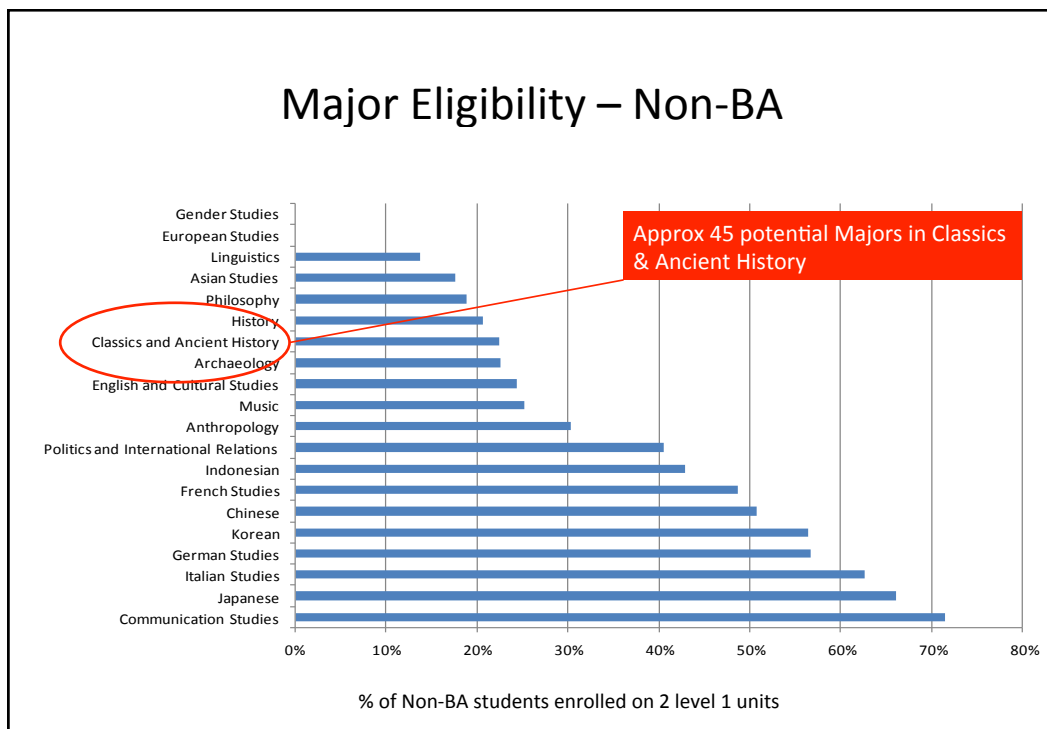
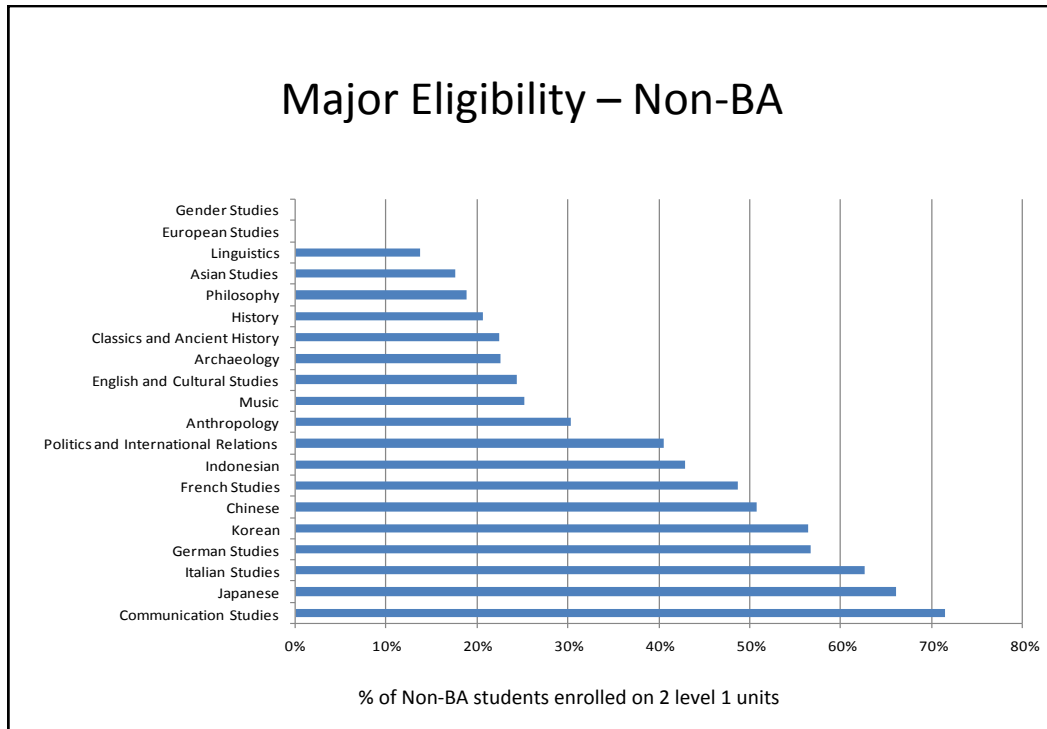

## Non-BA enrolments by Discipline

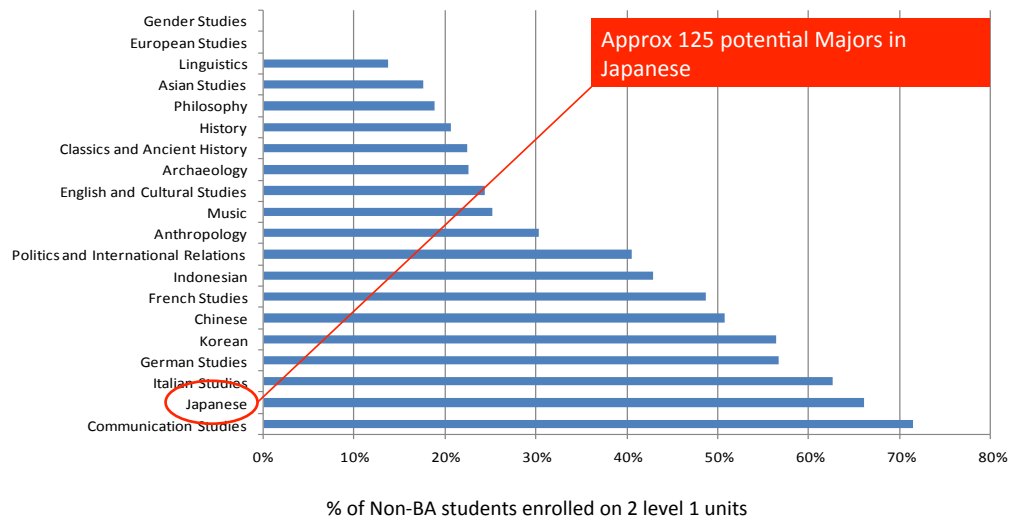

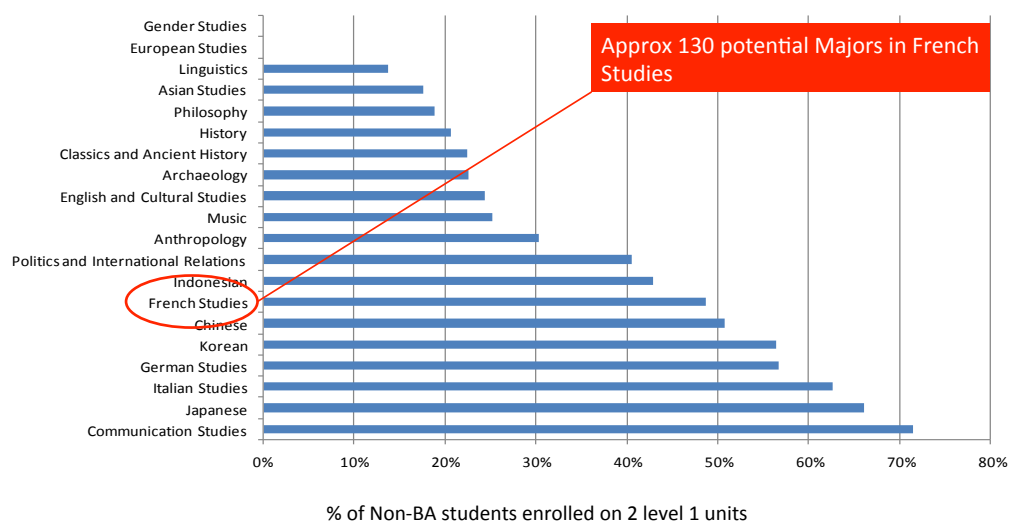




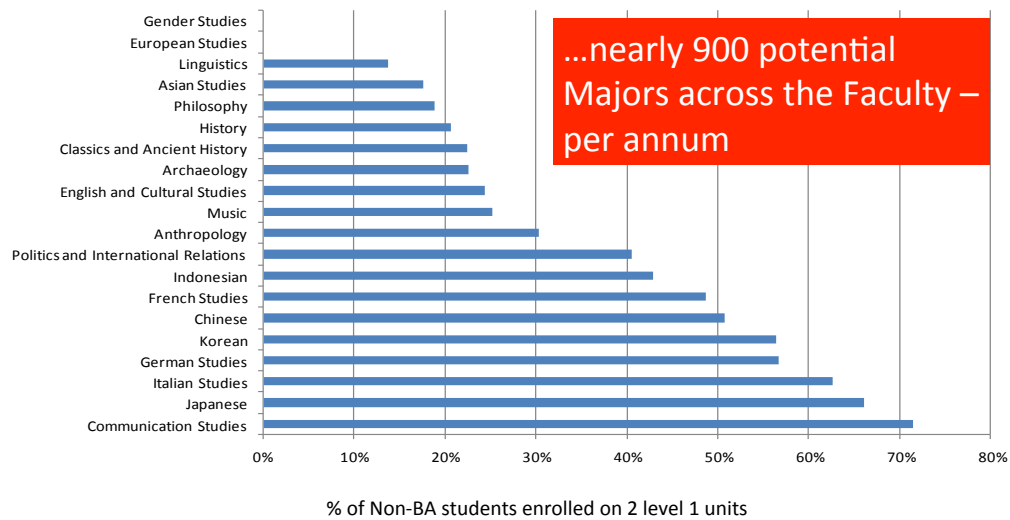
## Major Eligibility – Non-BA



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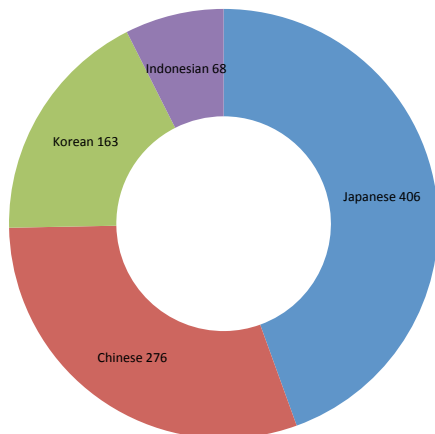

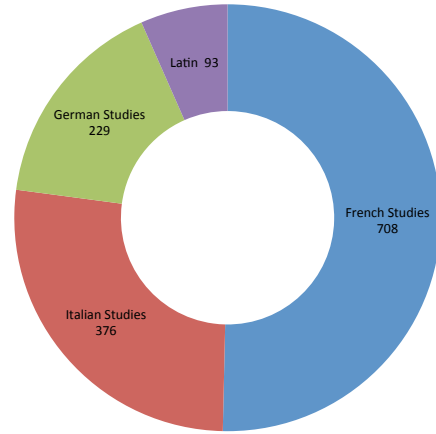

European Language Enrolments

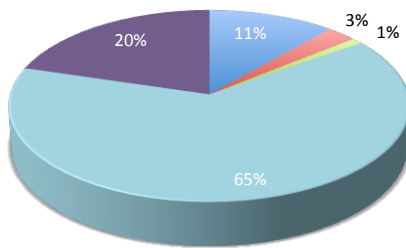

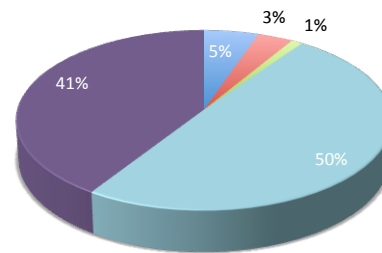

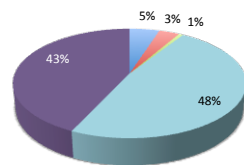

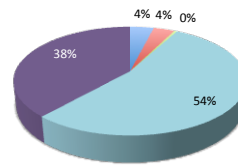

## Summary

- Enrolments dramatically up from last year
  - 27% overall
  - 42% for Semester 1 units
- Significantly more non-BA students (46% compared to 25% in 2011)
  - 82% from B Sci
  - Non-language Disciplines also affected
- Broadening requirement boost for languages
  - All languages up significantly
  - Dramatic increase for Asian languages
- Many broadeners could proceed to Majors.

## Implications for Arts

- Understanding our evolving student base
  - Pedagogical focus
  - Marketing
  - Identifying and growing 'pockets' of demand
- Broadeners – or second Major candidates?
- Resource implications
  - funding models
  - teaching loads
  - other

## Next steps

- Semester 2 enrolments
- Drop-out analysis
- BA students fulfilling broadening requirement using languages
- Shake-down effect from 2013
  - Greater proportion of Level 1 enrolments from NC students
  - Progression to Majors
- Consequences from alterations to other Majors: eg Psychology dropping complementary units, new CAT A units...
